The Buck Moon

The Tipping Point

The Open Door

Beneath the drama, Uranus trines Pluto with Neptune near the midpoint — a quiet, luminous opening. The same intensity that could scatter you can also crack you open to grace. Choose the spiritual current over the reactive one. Awakening is on offer for anyone willing to stay soft.

The buck grows his antlers in high summer, reaching full height, standing unhidden in the meadow. Let this moon be that: stand in your full stature, crowned and unafraid, rooted in the herd yet unmistakably yourself.
